Tobias Herzog, born 1994, studied jazz trombone at the Conservatory of music in Cologne. After he graduated his bachelor studies 2018 he started a master studies for jazz bass trombone at the Conservatory of music in Mainz where he also started playing tuba and where he graduated 2021. During his studies some important teachers were Henning Berg, Jan Schreiner, Shannon Barnett, Claudius Valk and Jürgen Friedrich.

He was member of the Youth Jazz Orchestra NRW (JJO NRW) and member of the German Youth Jazz Orchestra (BuJazzO).

As a sideman he got to play in many small combos, large ensembles and Big Bands, like the Subway Jazz Orchestra, WDR Big Band, Paul Heller All Star Big Band, Jazzkombinat Hamburg, Rundfunkanzorchester Ehrenfeld (RTO), Pascal Klewer Big Band, BBIKKE, Philipp Dornbuschs Großer Projektor, Victor Gelling TPCM, AHORN, Gaststätte zum Heissen Hirten, MOZAH, Valvetronic Brass Band, Cologne Contemporary Jazz Orchestra and many more.

As part of this projects he played a lot of concerts in Germany, Europe and the whole world, did recordings

in studios and also has his own projects, which is a solo for bass trombone and the sextet TRUCKER BABES. Therefore he is also active as a composer.

Tobias Herzog is living in Cologne where he is part of the lively musical scene as a bass trombonist, tubist, sousaphonist, teacher and composer, during his young career he already got to play with a lot of internationally known Jazz, Hip Hop and Pop artists like Peter Brötzmann, Herbert Grönemeyer, Christian Lillinger, Django Bates, Randy Brecker, John Beasley, Paquito D´Riviera, Kurt Rosenwinkel, Riles, Mine, Pablo Held, Kit Downes and many more.
